Today immediately following our service we are holding a Bake Sale. All of the proceeds are going towards our Organ Fund. There are no prices marked, please donate what you think is appropriate. Last week we collected \$190. We will receive another \$111 in matching funds from Thrivent. To date we have collected just over \$16000, which is approximately 60% of the needed funds. Once we collect 75%, we will be able to order our organ. If you are interested in donating, just mark ORGAN on your offering envelope or write ORGAN on your check.
