## Regarding the Lord's Supper

In the Lord's Supper Jesus Christ gives us His true body and blood for the forgiveness of all our sins. Matthew 26:26,28 Take and eat; this is my body... This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. All who have examined themselves and who believe what God's Word and the Lutheran Confessions teach concerning this holy sacrament are invited to commune with us. 1 Corinthians 11:28-29 But let a person examine himself and then eat of the bread and drink from the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the Lord's body brings a judgment on himself.

Paul commands us to examine ourselves before we approach the Lord's table. One way to examine ourselves is to ask ourselves three questions. They are:

1. Am I a sinner and am I sorry for my sins?
2. Do I believe in Jesus and His Word of promise in this sacrament? Do I believe that He gives me forgiveness of sins with His Body and Blood?
3. Will I amend my life? Will I strive to lead a more godly life?
